

conditions, payment, & cancellation/refund policy

Payment Schedule/Cancellation Policy

Payment: The \$75 application fee must accompany the Application for Enrollment and is non-refundable, and not applicable to tuition. Upon notification of acceptance into the program, a deposit of \$1,000 is due within 15 days, accompanied by an Enrollment Form to secure enrollment. The balance of the tuition, refundable fees and optional fees are invoiced by mail, and due by April 1 payable by check or money order only. **Credit cards are not accepted.** Full payment is due upon enrollment for students who apply after April 1.

Cancellation: All payments less \$350 are refundable until April 1, 2008. The balance of the tuition, refundable fees, and optional fees are due by April 1, 2008. Cancellation after April 1 to May 1 results in a \$1000 cancellation fee plus cost of nonrefundable airline ticket issued by Musiker Travel. Cancellation after May 1 to June 1 results in a \$2000 cancellation fee plus the cost of non-refundable airline ticket issued by Musiker Travel and fees for optional excursions. Cancellation after June 1 until two days prior to departure of the program results in a \$3000 cancellation fee plus the cost of nonrefundable airline ticket issued by Musiker Travel and fees for optional excursions. There is no adjustment in tuition for late arrivals or early departures. **There are no refunds whatsoever for cancellation within two days of the program departure or after the program commences, for any reason.**

Optional Travel Protection Plan is highly recommended. Information will be forwarded upon enrollment.

Academic Credit

Academic credit is conferred by UCLA, UCSB, UCSD, Penn and Northeastern University (NEU). Official transcripts are available (for a fee) from the above institutions for the purpose of applying to college or transferring credit. Although most colleges will accept appropriate UCLA, UCSB, UCSD, Penn or NEU credits, the decision to accept transfer of credits rests solely with the college you attend. SUMMER DISCOVERY is not responsible for the transfer/non-transfer of credit.

Some courses have been accepted for high school credit requirements. Students may inquire about the possibility of obtaining credit for a SUMMER DISCOVERY course from their high school prior to the program.

Scholarships

A **very limited** number of **partial tuition** scholarships are available to academically qualified (**3.5 minimum GPA**) students based on need. **Each year, scholarship requests far exceed the number of available scholarships.** Full scholarships are not available. Tax return information is required. Deadline for scholarship applications is March 15, 2008. Please contact the SUMMER DISCOVERY office for detailed financial disclosure, financial aid, and recommendation forms. Scholarships are not available for international programs. For U Penn scholarships, students must contact the university directly.

Conditions of Enrollment/General Information

SUMMER DISCOVERY does not discriminate in any of its policies, procedures and practices on the basis of race, religion, national or ethnic origin, or sex.

Students should be covered to protect them against loss/theft of baggage or personal belongings. SUMMER DISCOVERY is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.

SUMMER DISCOVERY may use photographs, videotapes and testimonials of students taken during the program.

The tuition and fees quoted here in are based on tariffs, costs of operations, insurance rates, energy costs, fuel prices, currency rates, and tuition fees as of August 15, 2007 and are subject to adjustment prior to commencement of the program.

International Students: Visas and Payment Procedure

Students and their families are responsible for obtaining any required Visas. Due to the brief period of time of the program, international students should obtain a short stay **TOURIST visa**, (not a STUDENT visa), from the American Embassy or Consulate in their home country.

All international payments must be made as follows (credit cards not accepted):

1. **By check** drawn on a US bank in US funds payable to SUMMER DISCOVERY (i.e. international money order) **or**
2. **By wire transfer** to include the following information:

Bank charges incurred are the responsibility of the student/parent. SUMMER DISCOVERY will credit only the actual payment in US dollars credited to SUMMER DISCOVERY by The First National Bank of Long Island.

International Students may postpone forwarding the \$75 Application Fee and instead remit \$1275 (\$75 Application Fee, \$200 International Registration and Health Insurance Fee, and \$1000 Program Deposit) upon acceptance to the program.

Special Note: All international students living outside North America and attending a program in the USA, will be invoiced a non-refundable **\$200 International Registration and Health Insurance Fee** which includes health/medical insurance coverage (with deductible) while attending SUMMER DISCOVERY, international courier fees, and airport meet and assist/airport transfers in the US.
