In the summer of 2020, FSSP students received over \$938,989 in grants, scholarships and loans. If you need financial aid to help cover the costs of the FSSP program, here are a few steps you <u>must</u> take:

STEP 1: Complete a 2020-21 FAFSA or California Dream Act Application (CADAA). The deadline for both applications is June 30, 2021; after this date your application <u>cannot</u> be processed.

• The 2020-21 application differs from the 2021-22 application which will be used for the upcoming Fall, Winter, & Spring quarters of the 2021-22 academic year.

STEP 2: Log into your My Aid Status portal with your UCSB Net ID and password. Once logged in, complete any required verification tasks.

STEP 3: Your Financial Aid Offer will be available in mid-July and can be viewed on your My Aid Status portal under the 2020-21 academic year tab. If you plan to accept student loans, please ensure that you complete <u>ALL</u> loan requirements in a timely manner.

REMINDERS:

- Fees are due August 4, 2021.
- In order to receive financial aid you must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 units.
- If you have accepted loans, make sure loan requirements are complete (promissory notes, entrance counseling).
- Monitor your UCSB email regularly, as all notifications will be sent to that email address.
- Your financial aid will post to your BARC account 10 days prior to the start date of your program.
