

In the summer of 2022, FSSP students received over \$684,132 in grants, scholarships and loans. If you need financial aid to help cover the costs of the FSSP Program, here are a few steps you **must** take:

- STEP 1: Complete a 2022-23 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or CA Dream Act Application (CADAA) by June 30, 2023; after this date your application <u>cannot</u> be processed.
 - The 2022-23 application is different from the 2023-24 application. If you want aid for summer, you will need the 2022-23 application on file.
- Log into My Aid Status with your UCSB Net ID and password. Make sure to complete any required tasks as soon as possible. Make sure that you are viewing the 2022-23 year in the upper right-hand corner.
- STEP 3: Summer awards are posted on a rolling basis beginning in early July. If you choose to accept any of your loans, you can do so on My Aid Status under the "Student Loan" tab.
 - All loans require a Master Promissory Note and Entrance Counseling Interview which are done on the Student Aid website.

REMINDERS:

- Fees are due on August 9, 2023.
- In order to receive aid, you must be enrolled in at least 6 units.
- If you have accepted loans, all loan requirements must be complete.
- Your aid will post to your BARC account 10 days prior to the first day of class.
- Please monitor your UCSB e-mail regularly, as all notifications will be sent to that email address.
